Argyll Cup Sniper Challenge

A challenge to your sniper skills and a confirmation of your marksmanship abilities, this is our SEVENTH ANNUAL sniper competition.

The challenge will take place in the MilCun training area, on a circuit approximately 6 kilometers long. You'll move through on foot, mostly on roads and well-marked trails; however there will be a short bush navigation and a water navigation (Jon boats provided). There will be 10 "stands," each focusing on one skill. Teams of two will work together to accomplish the aim of each test. The stands are:

- ❖ Range estimation
- ❖ Mid/long-range target location and engagement (sniper rifle)
- ❖ Fire & movement (sniper rifle)
- ❖ Land navigation
- ❖ Written skill test (3 sniper-related questions)
- ❖ Observation exercise
- ❖ Water navigation
- ❖ Ambush – close-range marksmanship (tactical rifle and pistol)
- ❖ Field firing (sniper rifle)
- ❖ Dash to the finish

- ❖ Range estimation
- ❖ Mid/long-range target location and engagement (sniper rifle)
- ❖ Fire & movement (sniper rifle)
