Five full days of professional marksmanship instruction for the sniper/precision rifle competition shooter – teaching to the National Service Conditions Championship (NSCC) course of fire – from 200 to 600 meters.

- How to think in a competition
- NSCC Competition – learn and understand popular matches from 200 to 600 meters
- Includes a competition: we will coach you through a real match - keep scorecards, understand the basic rules of competition, messages to the butts, react to the Range Officers instructions, deal with target problems, conduct in the butts and more



Cost

The course fee is \$975.00. This is an all-in price which includes instruction, range facilities, a daily onsite lunch, the match entry fee and all applicable taxes.
