It is intended for the police tactical team members and instructors who want to develop their pistol proficiency. We tune the content to the participants, and the intention is to move quickly through a review of marksmanship and accuracy exercises and move on to intermediate and advanced challenges. At the end of the course, your skills will be improved and you'll have a large repertoire of skills drills you can take back to your agency. Includes instruction and training practices in:

- Pistol marksmanship principles
- Grouping and zeroing
- Accuracy drills; speed drills ("Last One Standing")
- Consistency drills (Intro to the "50 Club")
- Stoppages and immediate actions (IAs)
- Applying the right sight picture (Sight-Picture Walk Back)
- Distance shooting with the pistol (Steel Walk Back to 100m)
- Low light shooting
- Dynamics, speed & accuracy with intensity ("Point & Shoot")
- Speed & multiple targets (Steel shoot)
- One-handed drills and IAs
- Support hand drills and IAs
- Stress shooting (Timed drills, e.g., Draw & fire on the timer)
- Stress games (E.g., "25-round run"; "Step-back double tap")



If you've taken any of our custom courses or if you're already a good shot and want to spice it up, this is the course for you.

Course test: Accuracy, Speed and Handling challenges - Standard: 80%

Course length: 4 days (0800 to 1700); approximately 15% classroom, 85% range work
