Prerequisites: Firearms marksmanship and handling.

Goal: To familiarize the students with the basics of long-range shooting, including some concentration in areas that would be of particular importance to forensic scientists, such as practical experience in some of the physical aspects of long range (+300 yds) shooting: ballistic trajectories, effects of wind, effects on target material and possible deflections from intermediary targets.

Main subject areas are:

- Rifle marksmanship

(equipment, accuracy, skill requirements)

- Long-range shooting (ballistics, elevations, grouping capabilities, reading the wind)
- Terminal ballistics (various calibers/bullets/energies at difference distances)
- Intermediate barriers (effects of intermediate barriers at distances; near muzzle and near target)



Course length: 5 days (0800 to 1700); approximately 20% classroom, 80% range work.

Course includes instruction, ranges, targetry, and the MilCun 'world-famous' hot lunches.
