Prerequisites: Prerequisites: There are no prerequisites for this course, but it is intended to support officers who have course development, teaching, and/or training responsibilities.

We include such topics as

- How to start at the end to get the right beginning
- How to design an effective test
- How to break the skill into 'do-able' and 'teach-able' chunks
- How to design a drill
- How to build effective classroom modules
- How to instruct in the classroom
- How to instruct on the range
- How to coach the individual

We'll teach our methods and then the participants will teach a module applying those methods.

Since everyone has to have pistol skills, we use the pistol as our example for this training. We'll include rifle whenever a course participant requires it.



Course test: Modules will be assessed for preparation, classroom instruction, range instruction, coaching.

Course length: 5 days (0800 to 1700); approximately 20% classroom, 20% workshop, 60% delivery

You will require both shooting and training equipment.

- MilCun will provide the teaching demonstration using the pistol.
- If you wish to teach your own modules in tactical rifle, let us know and we'll try to ensure all students bring appropriate equipment for that.

Pistol: For the pistol, bring your duty firearm, holster, magazines and pouches.

Ammunition: It is best if the ammo is all of the same type and the same lot. Quantities: 600-800 rounds

Rifle & Ammo: TBD

Training Aids: Laptop computer, any aids that you want to use to teach your lesson.
