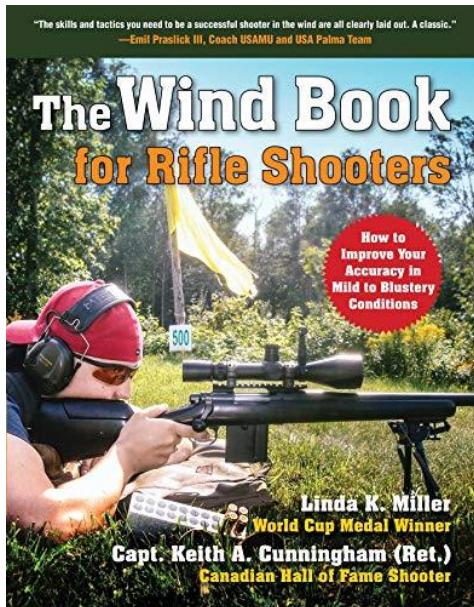


MilCun Training Center Wind Reading Course 2021

- Equipment – learn to use the EZ-Graf to center your group and stay in touch with the wind conditions
 - Wind Reading – direction & speed – establishing the first sight setting – the thought process
 - How to think about reading the wind in a competition
 - Practical wind reading exercises at 300 and 600 meters
 - This course will require you to spend more time reading the wind than shooting
- Learn the techniques used by Canadian National Rifle teams and many international shooters
